



N'tsiri Nature Reserve is a private use, 3651 hectare Big Five conservation reserve where wildlife roams freely across the unfenced borders with the Kruger National Park (on our Northern boundary), and the Klaserie and Timbavati Nature Reserves (to the West and South) – in total, an unfenced wilderness area of over 2 million hectares. It is home to natural game movement, magnificent Lowveld trees and an abundance of birdlife. Membership is limited to ensure that visiting N'tsiri remains a truly unique bushveld escape.
